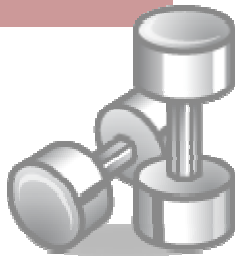

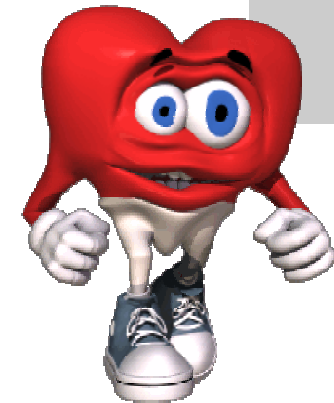

The Academy of Exercise Physiology and Sports Medicine

Single gender instruction in Physical Education, Science, and Social Studies addresses statewide standards while focusing on healthy lifestyles, wellness, anatomy, exercise physiology, and the historical implications of health and fitness. Students join the larger school environment for Language Arts, Math, and a second co-curricular class.

Other areas of instruction include personal safety, nutrition, CPR, and sports injury treatment.

Students participate in activities promoting wellness, fitness, and skill improvement. State of the art equipment and technology are used to develop individual health and fitness profiles. An optional after-school program and monthly family seminars are offered as an extension of the *GetFit!* Magnet Program.
